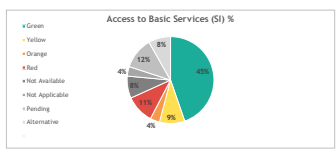

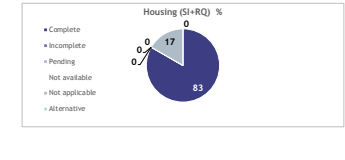
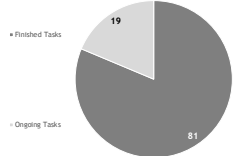

**Access to Basic Services Task Completion Status (SI+RQ) %**

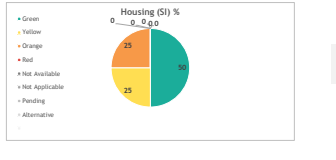

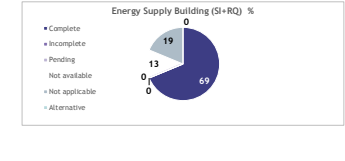

**1.1.2** Ratio of low cost housing within the housing stock

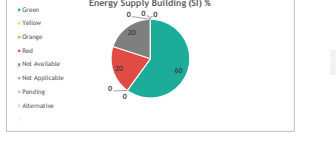

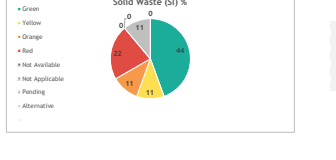

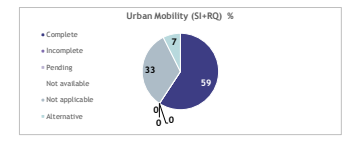

**1.6.1** Road density dedicated for public transport only (km / 100 000 population)

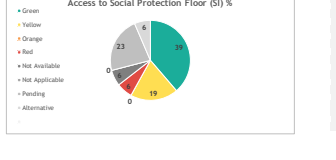
