Esteban Leon emphasized his eagerness to explore how to leverage Canadian expertise, stating, "Our goal is to bolster cities in the global south, in alignment with UN-Habitat's mission to cultivate more resilient and sustainable urban environments."

In the upcoming months, Evergreen and UN-Habitat will embark on a collaborative journey of project scoping and knowledge exchange, laying the foundation for their joint initiatives. Their collective aim is to fortify urban resilience, champion sustainable development, and pave the way for more prosperous and equitable cities. This MoU establishes a robust framework for cooperation, ensuring that both organizations work in synergy to enhance the institutional capacity of cities and community leaders on a global scale.
